



## Outside Cake Policy

At Farina, we take great pride in preparing and serving every dish that leaves our kitchen.

This commitment extends to our desserts and to the food safety standards we uphold. For this reason, we generally do not permit outside cakes or other food to be served in the restaurant.

There are several reasons for this policy:

### **Food Safety & Liability**

We cannot verify how an external cake has been prepared, transported, or stored. Once it is served on our premises, we assume a level of responsibility for our guests' wellbeing. To protect both our guests and our business, we must ensure that any food served in the restaurant meets appropriate food safety standards.

### **Supporting Our Business**

As a restaurant, our purpose is to prepare, serve, and sell the food we create. Our dessert menu is an important part of the dining experience and contributes to the sustainability of our business. Allowing outside food means foregoing the opportunity to serve the desserts we have carefully crafted.

### **Celebration Alternatives**
